Description of Agency or Boards

The Department of Historic Resources, established in the *Code of Virginia* §10.1-2201, encourages and supports the stewardship and use of Virginia's significant architectural, archaeological, and historic resources as valuable assets for the economic, educational, social, and cultural benefit of citizens and communities. Established as the Virginia Historic Landmarks Commission in 1966, the DHR helps citizens, state and federal agencies, and communities to reach their respective economic, education, and historic preservation goals and promotes the use of historic resources to build a better future for the Commonwealth of Virginia--supporting conservation and historic preservation goals, tourism and economic development, emergency and climate change preparedness, and education. DHR is a small agency with a large and complex mission and programs with high expectations for performance both internally and externally and a strong commitment to citizen access. Its organization and services have evolved over the decades fulfilling both state and federal mandates as Virginia's State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO). The Director of the Department is authorized to promulgate regulations in the *Code of Virginia* §10.1-2202(5).

The Virginia Board of Historic Resources is an official policy-making board of the Commonwealth of Virginia created by the *Code of Virginia* §10.1-2203. Its policies are implemented by the Department of Historic Resources, which day in and day out labors on behalf of our irreplaceable resources in the interest of the citizens of this Commonwealth. The Governor of Virginia selects members of the Board from volunteer and professional leaders of Virginia's history, preservation, and museum communities. Votes taken during this meeting are official actions of the Commonwealth of Virginia Board of Historic Resources. The Board's authority to promulgate regulations is established in the *Code of Virginia* §10.1-2205.

Title of Proposed Regulatory Action

Regulations Governing Contextualization of Monuments or Memorials for Certain War Veterans

Brief Overview

These are a new regulations pursuant to Chapters 1100 and 1101 of the 2020 Acts of Assembly. The chapters mandate in the 4th enactment clause: "That the Board of Historic Resources shall promulgate regulations governing the manner in which any monument or memorial may be contextualized pursuant to the provisions of this act." These regulations provide guidance to local governing bodies that choose to contextualize certain war monuments or memorials within their jurisdiction.
